Who will be affected -

The changes only affect viewers who receive their television services from the PanAmSat Pas 2 Satellite using the Scientific Atlanta Power Vu Satellite Receiver (as pictured below).

When -

The PanAmSat Pas 2 satellite service will cease on the 12th of June 2004, so before that time you need to make the necessary changes to your equipment.

What Does It Mean To You

- 1. You will need to replace your Scientific Atlanta Power Vu Satellite Receiver.
- GWN will replace all authorised and operating Scientific Atlanta Power Vu Satellite receivers for domestic viewers within regional Western Australia free of charge.
- You will also need to realign your satellite dish from the PanAmSat Paa2 Satellite to the Optus C1 satellite to enable the new receiver to operate. GWN has contracted Hills Antennas to help you realign your satellite dish. FREECALL Hills Antennas on 1800 720 000
